Transition Day

There will not be a catch-up session on Monday.

<u>Drop-off and Collection Times – September 2021</u>

In September, we will maintain our staggered start and finish times. We have noticed that this small amendment has had a positive impact on congestion and the pressures of parking nearby to the school. To ensure everyone's safety





will open the gates to allow parents to enter the playground, but this will not be before 8:45am. Until your child enters the **school building** parents are fully responsible for their children and they will not be supervised. No FS or KS1 child should be left unattended.

Isolation Periods

Due to the current high levels of Covid-19 in Salford, the LA is asking schools not to relax restrictions on July 19th but instead to introduce these new measures at the start of the new term in September. We will therefore continue to operate under our current risk assessment and related health and safety procedures for the last few days of the Summer Term. This means, for example, that children will still be taught in designated bubbles, social distancing rules will be maintained. School will also be supporting children with regular handwashing and other hygiene requirements that help prevent the spread of the virus.

The LA will continue to support schools with Covid-19 testing and to identify children who need to isolate as a result of either having Covid-19, or being a contact of another child or adult who has tested positive.

Amendment to school holiday dates 2021-2022

To enable schools to celebrate the Platinum Jubilee of Her Majesty the Queen, the late May Bank Holiday (originally 30th May 2022) has been moved to Thursday 2 June 2022, with an additional Bank Holiday on Friday 3 June.

The DfE have reduced the minimum number of sessions schools are required to meet in the academic year 2021/22 to allow for the additional bank holiday. As the additional bank holiday falls in the half term dates already set by the LA, the finish date at the end of the Autumn term has been amended for community and voluntary controlled schools to reflect the reduction in the required number of teaching days. School will now close on Tuesday 21st December 2021 at 1.30pm. Please find attached an amended school calendar to reflect this change.
