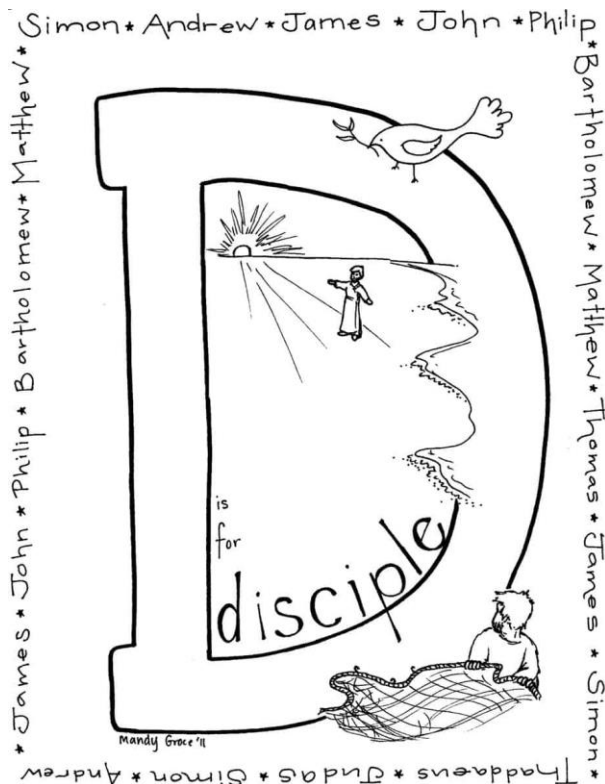
WELCOME TO OUR PARISH
