Winter	<p>Grey trousers, dress or skirt.</p> <p>EYFS: White polo shirt in early years without a tie. KS1 and KS2: Plain white blouse / shirt – suitable to be worn with a tie. Ties must be worn from KS1 onwards.</p> <p>Royal blue V-neck sweatshirt / cardigan.</p> <p>Sensible black shoes in terms of appearance and suitability. No trainers, high heels or high-wedged shoes are to be worn.</p>
Summer	<p>Grey short trousers Blue and white checked dress White or grey socks No sandals, trainers, high heels or high-wedged shoes are to be worn.</p>

P.E. KIT	<p>Black shorts Plain white t-shirt (no motifs) Black pumps</p>
KS2 OUTDOOR PE KIT	<p>Plain white t-shirt Black tracksuit top and bottoms (no motifs) Trainers</p>

The only permitted jewellery items are:
